An impressive educational tool

Haut-Kœnigsbourg castle is an exceptional educational tool for the young. There are many educational activities provided for school or educational groups of all ages.

All the activities presented at the castle are original and concern a wide variety of fields and disciplines: from history to heritage via architecture, French, civic education...

A unique opportunity to study the Middle Ages through daily life in a fortress, as well as the 19th and 20th centuries, the period during which the monument was restored by Kaiser Wilhem II.



Discover

→ Unaccompanied tour

Youngsters aged from 3 to 18 explore the castle freely, accompanied by their teacher or presenter. Educational documents in English are available to facilitate preparation and the visit itself.

→ Discovery tour in English

Accompanied by a guide, the children set off to explore a medieval fortress restored in the early 20th century. Its history, architecture, restoration and daily life in the 15th century are among the themes covered to give a general overview of the monument.

→ Fun tour

Different times, different customs... the fun tour is presented by Florine the Apothecary, Franz the Innkeeper or one of the other characters who live in the castle. Through this original experience, the children have an immersion course in daily life and the particularities of life in a medieval castle.

→ In-depth tour

Based on the discovery tour, this one provides more in-depth information about the different themes and gives a detailed picture of the monument and its history.

→ Thematic tour

This tour concentrates on a single subject chosen on reservation. The themes available are architecture, restoration of the monument and daily life in a fortress at the end of the Middle Ages.

→ Heritage workshops

Within the context of heritage workshops, the children alternate touring the castle with in-depth and practical sessions in the classroom. Several themes are available: daily life in the Middle Ages, architecture and construction of a fortress, defensive architecture, food in the Middle Ages, heraldry, the art of war in the Middle Ages, the medieval garden and the restoration of the monument.

→ Heritage class

During a 2 to 5 day stay, Haut-Kœnigsbourg provides classes for all levels to study the many facets of the castle and its history from the Middle Ages to the present day. The programme, defined with the teacher, combines tours, workshops and presentations during the day or in the evening by heritage professionals and experts in historical crafts.

→ Terms of reservation

Reservation is mandatory.

We recommend that you contact our reception and reservation department for advice in choosing the most appropriate tour or activity. From Monday to Friday (from 09:00 to 12:30 and from 14:00 to 17:30).

→ A new audiovisual interpretative centre

Principally aimed at persons with reduced mobility, this facility enables visitors to explore the château by means of a trilingual virtual tour. This tour can be tailored to cater to varying levels of understanding in line with visitors' age or disability type. The new centre is also used for educational purposes all Tuesdays (Heritage workshops).

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
