The mill: an audiovisual interpretative centre for visitors with reduced mobility

On the tour of the castle there are numerous obstacles, including over 300 steps, which make access difficult for people with mobility problems.


To enable visitors with reduced mobility to see the Castle of Haut-Kœnigsbourg, and learn about its history and collections, a 20 min. film is shown on the ground floor of the mill.

It tells the story of the turbulent history of this symbolic example of European Heritage. It charts the main historical milestones of the monument, from the Hohenstaufen to the bandit knights, from the Habsburgs to Emperor William II. As you explore the castle, from the Kaiser's Hall to the armoury, from the artillery platform to the living quarters, you will discover architecture, interiors, furnishings and an atmosphere that are rich in history.

To reach the mill

The mill is in the castle's lower courtyard.

Only those with an electronic identification badge can gain access to the projection room.



The electronic identification badge

This identification badge should be worn around your neck and presented to the badgereader which is near the mill entrance. The door will open automatically.

It is valid for 1 person and for 1 session and should be returned at the end of the session in exchange for your proof of identity.

In the lower courtyard



An information terminal will show you:

- the number of seats available during the current session
- how long you will have to wait before the next session

You can then go up the ramp leading to the entrance.

You can leave the room during the session by pressing this button.



Seating

Up to 18 people may be simultaneously present at each projection, 7 of whom may be in wheelchairs.

The film

Duration: 20 mins.

You can access the film in different ways:

- by listening on your headset
- through sub-titles
- through French sign language



Please note that these different modes of access are independent of each other.

The headset

The headset you have been given has been programmed with your choice of commentary. You can change to a different commentary by turning the grey wheel. Each number corresponds to one of these channels:
